



Children's Physicians Medical Group (CPMG) is an Independent Physicians Association (IPA) comprised of Pediatricians and Pediatric Specialists associated with Rady Children's Hospital-San Diego. CPMG contracts with Health Plans and third parties to support the Children's Healthcare Integrated Delivery System in a managed care environment. We provide a central contracting approach for our member physicians in San Diego and southern Riverside counties and support a network of over 750 providers for 67,000 patients.

CPMG is currently seeking qualified candidates for the position of Case Manager.

Brief job description:

To coordinate the delivery of care through assessment, planning, facilitation, and patient advocacy to ensure cost-effective, quality outcomes of care. The case manager works with all members of the health care team to ensure optimal outcomes are reached while appropriate utilization occurs.

Position Responsibilities (include but are not limited to):

- Conducts prior, concurrent, and retroactive review of authorization requests to determine medical necessity and coverage criteria.
- Participates in discharge planning with inpatient staff to ensure timely and appropriate discharge or change in level of care, as well as coordination of necessary follow-up care.
- Identifies, through direct referral, provider referral, and clinical review of inpatient admission or prior authorization, and utilization data, appropriate members for case management intervention.
- Assists members in accessing additional resources outside of the insurance benefits including alternative funding sources, support networks, and disease management programs, etc.
- Coordinates and communicates UM activities with other members of the CPMG UM team.
- Reviews pertinent clinical and authorization requests with CPMG Medical Director when benefit limitations are evident, medical necessity is not apparent, or clinical concerns arise.
- Additional responsibilities as required.

Minimum job qualifications (education, experience, certification, skills, etc):

- Registered nurse with current unrestricted California License.
- Strong computer skills to include Excel, Word, PowerPoint, Outlook, and Access.
- Demonstrated initiative with developed critical thinking skills.
- Ability to work independently and organize time effectively.
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills.

Preferred job qualifications:

- Case management certification preferred.
- A minimum of three years clinical experience, with pediatric background.
- At least 2 years managed care experience with utilization or case management.
